- ◆ Pre K dancers <u>MUST</u> utilize the restroom in Studio B <u>BEFORE</u> checking in.

- ♦ Dancers may not arrive no earlier than five minutes before their scheduled class. (Students are allowed to hang inside/outside the studio between scheduled classes).
