What do the dancers wear to the rehearsal & What do I do once I get to the rehearsal?

- Dancers will wear their normal class dance attire at the rehearsal. Pre-K dancers classes
 can wear their ballet shoes and all other dancers need to bring both pairs of their dance
 shoes in a labeled bag (if applicable). Dancers DO NOT wear recital costumes and
 recital shirts at the rehearsal. Hair and makeup DOES NOT have to be done for the
 rehearsal.
- Once the parent/guardian checks the dancer in, the parent/guardian can wait in the lobby area or in their car. <u>Dancers need to utilize the restroom upon arrival at the rehearsal by their parents or guardian. NO PARENTS OR GUESTS ARE ALLOWED to stay in the auditorium at the REHEARSAL.</u> Please be patient as we navigate through the rehearsal process. Once dancers are done with their routine(s) we will text you to come pick them up inside the lobby area. <u>DO NOT LEAVE THE PREMISES.</u>
- Parents will receive the order of the program on the week of <u>June 2nd via Google Classroom</u> (so, they are aware of what costumes dancers wear for each number, dance shoes, finale attire, etc.) <u>Hair and Makeup is the same as Picture Day for the recital.</u>
- Dancers will receive Costume #2, Trophy, Certificate, Five Recital Tickets and the Recital Souvenir Booklet in June (Date TBA).
- The Last day to pay balances is Thursday, June 12th. Balances must be paid in FULL to participate in the rehearsal and the recital. In addition, their balance must be paid in full in order to receive their Trophy, Certificate, Five Recital Tickets and the Souvenir Booklet. No EXCEPTIONS!

What do the dancers wear to the Recital?

The dancer and ONE parent/guardian will enter on the left entrance of the building. (You'll see signage) The parent will drop the dancer off in the dressing room. Once the parent/guardian drops off the dancer in the dressing room area, the parent/guardian will stand in line (on the right entrance of the building). Make sure you take your dancer to the restroom prior to dropping them off in the dressing room area.

- Dancers will wear their first costume they perform in. (More info TBA). After they finish
 their first routine, parent/guardian will <u>IMMEDIATELY</u> go back to the dressing room to
 change their dancer's into their second costume for their second routine.
- After their last routine, parents will put the recital shirt on their dancer with animal print/tribal print bottoms of their choice with ballet shoes, jazz shoes or tennis shoes and both the dancer and parent/guardian will report to the auditorium to watch the remainder of the recital. (Parents need to save their dancer a seat in the auditorium).
- The host will announce for all dancers to report to the dressing room for the finale. Parents will drop off their dancer in the dressing room (and pick them up following the finale) in the dressing room.
- Hair and makeup (will be the same as the photoshoot) should be done prior to reporting to the recital. If they are in multiple pieces that require a makeup change, please do so quickly in the dressing room. Parent/guardian is not allowed to stay or conjugate backstage once they have changed their dancer's costume. CAMERAS ARE NOT ALLOWED IN THE DRESSING ROOM. Refrain from taking pictures in the dressing room. We have designated areas at the recital for pictures. Parent/Guardian should have all their dancer's dance shoes, tights, accessories, costumes, t-shirt, bottoms, bags labeled with their name on it.

What is the attire for the recital?

• We suggest parents and guests purchase a recital shirt and rock it with animal print or tribal print bottoms. Any animal print or tribal attire is highly suggested! (Last day to pre-order recital shirts is May 28th).

When and Where may I purchase tickets?

Tickets go on sale at the studio on Monday, May 5th for \$20.00 each at the studio only. Each student receives five tickets (per show they are in). The deadline to purchase tickets is Thursday, June 19th at the studio. Limited tickets will be sold at the door for \$25.00 (Debit/Credit) Only. Ticket Purchases are non-refundable.

When will the doors open for each show?

- Doors open <u>15</u> minutes before the start of each recital. Dancers don't need a ticket for the recital(s) they are performing however, they will need a ticket to attend recitals they are not performing in. <u>Guests will need tickets for every recital they attend.</u>
- Please be patient as we navigate through the transition of each recital.
- There will be a designated time after each recital to take pictures and conjugate in the foyer before it must be cleared in preparation for the next recital.
- Only Debit/Credit Cards are allowed. (Cash less Recital)
- There will be BRPD Officers onsite.
- Guests may not save seats.
- Balloons are not allowed inside the auditorium.
- There will be concessions at all the recitals, however food and drinks are NOT ALLOWED INSIDE THE AUDITORIUM.
- We encourage parents/guardians to bring their dancer flowers and trinkets following their performance. They have worked so hard these past few months!
